Stem	(2) strips @ 5"	Sub-cut into (12) 5" squares
Rectangles	(3) strips @ 4 1/2"	Sub-cut into (48) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
Flying Geese Units	(6) strips @ 6 1/2" wide	Sub-cut into (32) 6 1/2" squares
Setting Triangles	(2) strips @ 15 1/2"	Sub-cut into (4) 15 1/2" squares Cut each square on both diagonals to yield 16 triangles
Border #1	(8) strips @ 4 1/2"	
Border #3	(9) strips @ 6 1/2"	
SASHING SQUARES and 2ND BORDER — 1.5 m or 1 $^2/_3$ yds		
Centre Corner Stones	(1) strip @ 5 1/2"	Sub-cut into (5) 5 1/2" squares
Half-sashing Squares	(1) strip @ 5 ⁷ / ₈ "	Sub-cut into (2) 5 ⁷ / ₈ " squares Cut each of these in half on one diagonal
Corner Triangles		From the remainder of the strip, cut(2) squares 4 1/2" — sub-cut the squares in half on one diagonal
First Border Accent Squares and Corner Triangles	(2) strips @ 4 1/2"	Sub-cut into (12) 4 1/2" squares for First Border and (2) 4 1/2" squares (Corner Triangles) cut on one diagonal
Border #2	(9) strips @ 2 1/2"	
BINDING — .75m or ⁷ / ₈ yd — Colour of your choice		
Binding	(10) strips @ 2 ½"
